During the eight weekends of the fair, you are exposed to all aspects of brewing using 15th and 16th century techniques and experience what it means to work at a renaissance festival. We promise long days and hard work and memories to last a lifetime.

To be considered for a position all applicants must meet the following minimum standards:

- Written Application
- Be a non-smoker (participants are not permitted to smoke at the fair and Brigadoon is smoke free workplace)
- Be at least 21 years of age
- Be able to lift 30 lbs
- Be able to stand for long periods
- Have or be able to get TABC Service Certificate
- Be a citizen of the United States or hold a valid work visa.
- Have a valid SSN
- Pass a background investigation
- Agree to follow all company and Texas Renaissance Festival rules
- Not currently on probation
- Not convicted or charged with a sex crime

If selected, you will be expected to provide the following:

1. Proof of SSN
2. Valid Picture State ID
3. Complete Training (oral and written)
4. Attend dress rehearsal
5. TABC Service Certificate Number
6. Provide your own costume. We can assist if there are questions. (All costumes must be approved prior to opening weekend.)

F.A.Q.

1. Will I get free time to see the fair?
 - a. Yes, approximately 6 hours daily minimum.
2. Why do I have to be 21?
 - a. You will be handling alcohol and have access to alcohol. (No exceptions!)
3. What will I do?
 - a. Sweep, clean the sales area, stock, greet customers, pour beer, server beer, work sales counter help where needed.
4. What days will I be expected to work?
 - a. Every Sat and Sun for 8 weekends of faire and the Friday after thanksgiving.
5. What does the brewery provide?
 - a. We provide 3 meals on Thanksgiving Friday and Saturday and 2 meals on Sunday.
 - b. You will have the opportunity to sample several brews both house brews and commercial brews. (No drinking while on duty.)
 - c. Shift Beer
 - d. Serving Training and beer education.
 - e. An experience that you will never forget.
6. Where do I stay?
 - a. You can camp in participant campgrounds at no cost.
 - b. You can stay in our bunk house if there is room. (Fills up quickly.)
7. What will I be paid?
 - a. Starting salary is \$10 per hour.
 - b. Tips
 - c. Profit sharing and bonuses are available.
 - d. Eligible for preferred position next year.
8. What is an average day like? Individual schedules vary.)
 - 7:30 – 8:00 Breakfast (Optional)
 - 10:00 -11:00 Serve
 - 11:00 – 12:00 Lunch
 - 12:00 – 2:00 Serve
 - 2:00 – 3:00 Break
 - 3:00 – 5:00 Serve
 - 5:00 – 5:30 Break
 - 5:30 – 6:30 serve
 - 6:30 Off for the day
 - 8:00 Fair Closes
 - 9:00 Dinner and a movie at the brewery (optional)
 - 11:00 Quite time starts
 - 12:00 lights out.
